I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Templeton called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

III. COMMITTEE BUSINESS

A. Public Safety: Rights of Individual vs. Well Being of the Community

The Committee received and discussed a presentation from Division Chief Mike Boyle, Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA), on the topic of OCFA's response to hoarding. He emphasized that hoarding cases require a multi-disciplinary approach and are largely related to mental health issues. OCFA enforces the California Fire Code, which includes storage limits for hazardous and flammable materials. The Fire Code does not contain standards for ordinary combustibles, such as papers. OCFA participates in the Orange County Task Force on Hoarding and can make referrals to the Task Force or Adult Protective Services.

The Committee discussed the need for public information relating to the safe disposal of ammunition and fire extinguishers, as well as the possibility that the City could refer residents to hoarding resources.

Ray Gross, resident, asked the Committee to consider collaborating with Laguna Woods Village on a fire safety program and noted that the Village's Social Services Department addresses hoarding cases.

B. "Stand By Your Pan" Campaign

The Committee reviewed and provided comments to Division Chief Mike Boyle on the Orange County Fire Authority's "Stand By Your Pan" Campaign. General comments included that the video was hard to follow and lacked a clear message. The City will play the video on Channel 31 and will ask Channel 6 to consider doing the same.

Stu Venable was appointed, without objection, to the Land Use and Design Review Committee's Landscape Subcommittee.
