Laguna Woods residents are able to schedule door-to-door collections of household hazardous waste on an as-needed basis. There is no charge for doing so. WM Curbside, the City's contract service provider, will make arrangements to collect materials that residents assemble from outside of their homes.

- ✗ No ammunition
- ✗ No explosives
- ✗ No radioactive materials
- ✗ No appliances
- ✗ No liquid mercury
- ✗ No roadside flares
- ✗ No asbestos
- ✗ No medication
- ✗ No collections consisting of only sharps waste, motor oil, or oil filters
- ✗ No biological waste
- ✗ No tires

Please drop-off household batteries at City Hall. Vehicle batteries will not be accepted.



Sharps Waste

Please drop-off home-generated sharps waste at City Hall. Sharps must be dropped off in a rigid and needle puncture-resistant container (e.g., laundry detergent bottles, soda bottles, or medical sharps containers).
